

From Black Sand to the Rose

The Transformative Role of Image in Sandplay Therapy

Seminar Overview

This seminar offers an in-depth exploration of the processes of transformation at work in children confronted with rupture, loss. Through symbolic work with **sand, images, creative processes, and land art**, we will explore how early difficult experiences can gradually be represented, worked through, and integrated.

The **guiding thread of the seminar** unfolds through several interconnected movements:

- **Black Sand** – evoking origins marked by separation, chaos, or the unspeakable
- **Emergence of Form** – in sandplay and natural environments, allowing expression without words
- **From Rupture to Relationship** – supported by shared creative experiences
- **From Wounded Child to Hero** – emergence of inner resources and symbolic courage
- **The Rose** – representing transformation and the reorganization of attachment

Special attention is given to the **role of the image**, often misunderstood theoretically, but central to sandplay therapy. Images are living expressions of the psyche, allowing inner experience to take form before it can be thought or verbalized.

Seminar Setting

The seminar takes place in a **welcoming residential house**, a unique place of care in Belgium, surrounded by nature. The center offers both **seminars and residential retreats**, providing time for introspection, integration, and personal development.
